DOCUMENTATION OF SOLO PASSAGE

New entrants must document that they have made at least one nonstop singlehanded passage **under sail** on the boat being entered in the Lake Ontario 300 Solo Challenge, covering a distance of **not less** than 100 statute miles **AND** requiring a passage time of **not less** than 24 hours. If a different boat is used for the solo qualification passage, a complete description of the type of boat is to be provided to GLSS BOD or their appointees for consideration and approval. **Entrants have until July 10, 2011 to complete their solo qualification passage.** The GLSS and its appointees have the right to reject any entries for any reason that they deem sufficient.
